Alere works with your physician

Alere coordinates the plan of care established by your physician. We communicate your progress with your physician, nurse midwives, insurance case manager and other care providers. 1. Insurance

An Alere representative will contact you to help with insurance authorization, processing claims and special needs. A co-pay may be required.

2. Nurse visit

Your nurse will also discuss your condition, signs and symptoms, medication, side-effects, nutritional needs and self-monitoring. If you have any questions about your condition, your nurse will take the time to explain the answers thoroughly.

3. Medication & equipment delivery

If your condition requires pumps, monitoring equipment or medication, these materials will be delivered right to your home. We'll also be sending educational materials to help you stay informed.

4. Follow-up
